Overview

This is a summary of the key milestones for us as a Diocese as we develop Mission Action Plans for each Deanery (dMAPs).

September 2013	Diocesan Synoo	d Conference t	forms the 4	strategic priorities (4SPs)

March 5 Lent Course begins, parishes explore the 4SPs together

March 15 Diocesan Synod briefed on the dMAP Process

April 30 Deaneries to have completed a review of the Deanery Mission and Pastoral

Committee (dMPC) in the light of the responsibility being given to it, and

amended its membership and function as required.

May 31 Review Phase information to have been gathered using the 4SPs as a lens,

and a 2 page summary circulated to all PCCs in the Deanery.

July 31 Deanery Consultation completed, providing ideas and suggestions for the

dMPC to summarise and prioritise. Draft dMAP to be produced with 4 or 5 key objectives, and their associated resource implications and priorities. This

draft dMAP to be circulated to all PCCs for their comment and input.

September 30 dMPC to have received all input from PCCs. dMPC to have considered and

re-worked the draft dMAP as required, and produced a final dMAP proposal,

and circulated to the dMAP Support Group for advice and comment.

November 21 Final version of dMAP to have been debated and approved at Deanery Synod

November 22 Presentation and celebration of dMAPs at Winchester Cathedral. Launch of

the Parish MAPs.
