Faculty Jurisdiction Rules 2015 Rule 9.9 (2)

In the Consistory Court of the Diocese of Winchester

PARISH: SHOLING

CHURCH: ST MARY

PROPOSED WORKS: Alterations to church hall to increase flexible use of space including upper floor with lift and stair access, new toilets. Improve east entrance and relationship to main road with new footpath access.

Form new principal entrance in north east part of the north transept to create full level access to church. Part removal of vestry to church to accommodate new entrance with that of hall. New mezzanine in north transept accessed from staircase and lift as part of all alterations. Glazed end overlooking church. Beneath mezzanine install folding sliding partition to allow separate use of nave area. To west of church remove organ and dispose. Install new vestry, storage, accessible toilet and servery as well as audio visual control desk. Reform floor to main church to level floor finishes and accommodate new underfloor heating. Main church floor to be timber finish with that of north transept in ceramic tile limestone paving look. New heating system with boiler room within existing basement room beneath south porch. Install new lighting throughout. In Chancel remove existing 1970s choir stalls for more flexible use of chancel.

A PETITION has been submitted to the Court in respect of the proposed works detailed above, which fall within the categories of proposed works required by the Faculty Jurisdiction Rules 2015 to be notified by publication on the Diocesan Website.
