

THE BLUE ROOM AT WOLVESEY

If you'd like somewhere to be alone with God for a day, Wolvesey is easy to get to – and surprisingly quiet.

Primarily for clergy, LLMs and those in training, the Blue Room is available on Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays during the school term, from 9.30am – 5.30pm.

The room (upstairs) is large, warm and comfortably furnished, and overlooks the garden. There is a kitchen with facilities for making hot drinks, and a fridge and microwave.

You are welcome to use the chapel (not heated!), to explore the garden and of course the city and surrounding countryside. You may like to attend Evensong in the Cathedral at 5.30pm, in which case you can leave your car at Wolvesey until after the service.

There is no charge for using the Blue Room. If you'd like to make a donation, we suggest £5 in 'summer' or £10 in 'winter'.
