



### A Guide to the Bishop's Commission for Mission Training Programmes (BCM)



#### What is the BCM?

Bishop's Commission for Mission

BCM is a suite of lay training programmes focused on enabling church members to live missionally in every part of their lives, equipping them to live out their vocation to the full. Through participating in the programme we believe God will shape each trainee for his or her place in his mission.

#### What does a BCM Involve?

The BCM Programme consists of an opening and closing Saturday and 6 sessions spread out over a term. We ask participants to commit to be present at every session so that they and those they are learning with get the most of out of the training. Safeguarding training will also be required for commissioning. This is not an academic programme but a formative learning experience.

#### How do I take part?

To sign up for the training programme participants will need to be recommended by their incumbent and PCC, who will usually pay the training costs. Those who successfully complete the programme will be commissioned by the Bishop of Winchester for their BCM role at the annual Lay Ministries Service in Winchester Cathedral in October.
